

Device Licensing for UniVerse 10.2.x Server Edition

Abstract

The DLUV package is not recognized as a package by the licensing process in UniVerse 10.2.

There are two things to note about this package.

1. While attempting to install the DLUV package (uvregen -p DLUV:2) you receive the following error.

```
'Invalid package name: DLUV'
```

2. If attempting to modify the number of connections per device to 1 (uvregen -d 1) you will receive the following message.

```
'Invalid # of connections per device: 1'
```

Cause

DLUV is no longer a package in terms of the software but appears that way on the license details documentation to make it clear that it has been supplied. Additionally, there are two columns for the license count of the DLUV package, '#Users' and 'Auth Users'. The column '#Users' is the number of additional connections per device you have purchased. The total number is the value in the 'Auth Users' column, and it is this value that should be used when licensing the software..

Answer

When installing DLUV use the -d option of uvregen rather than 'package installation'.

e.g.

```
uvregen -p DLUV:3 <- This will produce an 'Invalid package' error.
```

```
uvregen -d 3 <- This will initialize device licensing for 3 sessions per user and produce a configuration code.
```

Also ensure the correct value is used when licensing UniVerse (the value in the 'Auth Users' column).
